






SATURDAY, THE WEDDING

Draping was brought down, vendors were on lifts installing lighting, the band was setting the stage, the cake was brought in and put into place, catering tables were being whisked in, etc.

After the hour was up, we were finally able to drop the drape and reveal the space to guests. Jackson Durham created incredible, towering floral arrangements to fill the open space of the venue. We incorporated a mix of round tables, mirrored communal high boys, and banquette seating to encourage guests to get up and mingle. The decor elements of this wedding were over the top and amazing!


Bold American brought in dinner stations which included mason jar stacks of shrimp and grits, a mac and cheese station complete with biscuits, and a steak carving station.


We also brought in a slow-mo video booth which had a line the entire night long.

The biggest hit of the night might have been the airbrush hat station. Kelly supplied us with 300 neon trucker hats prior to the wedding. We had a station set up at the wedding with airbrush artists who were live painting the hats with whatever name combination and colors guests wanted. It was a huge hit and so fun to see the completed hats on the dance floor!











At midnight, the wedding reception ended and guests gathered outside to send Matthew and Kelly off in style amidst a sea of sparklers. Guests were greeted outside with the Varsity food truck – and refueled with hamburgers, onion rings, fries and hot dogs.
